



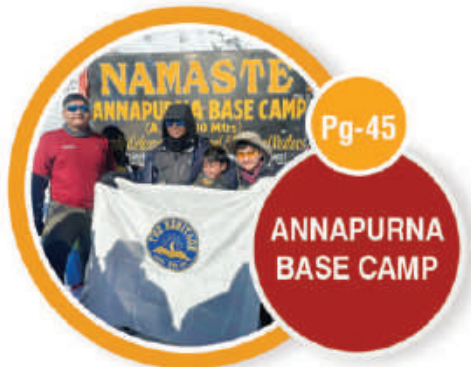

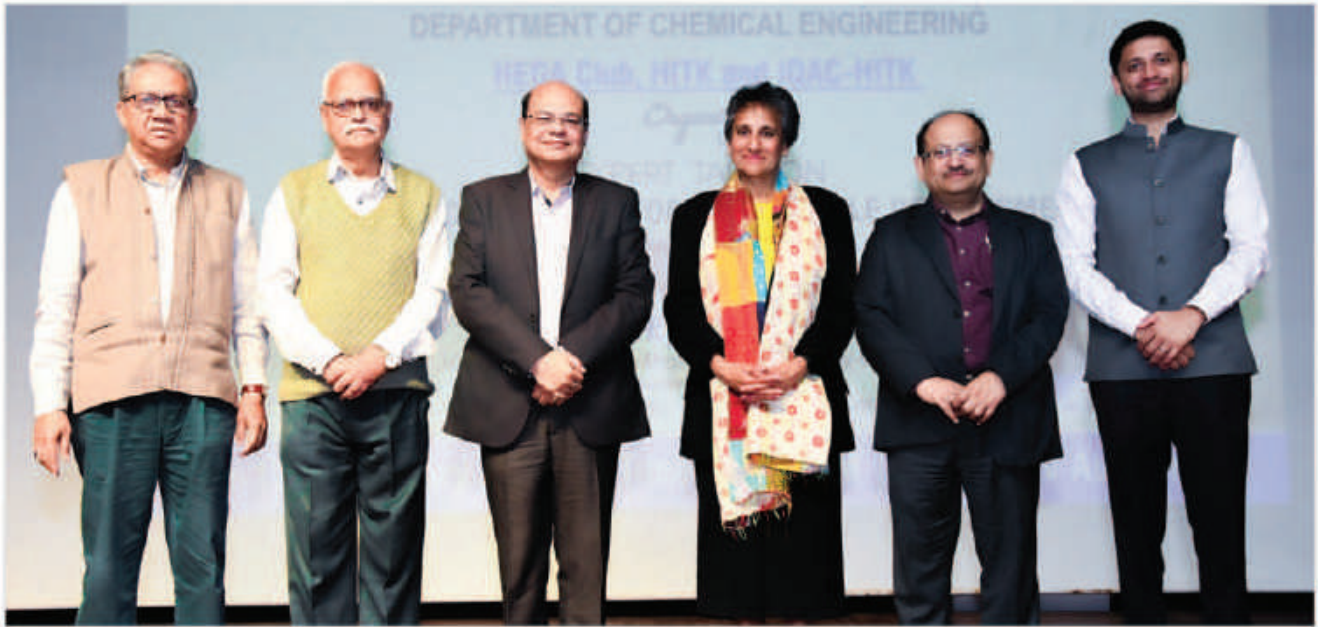

BHARAT SAAS YATRA CELEBRATING

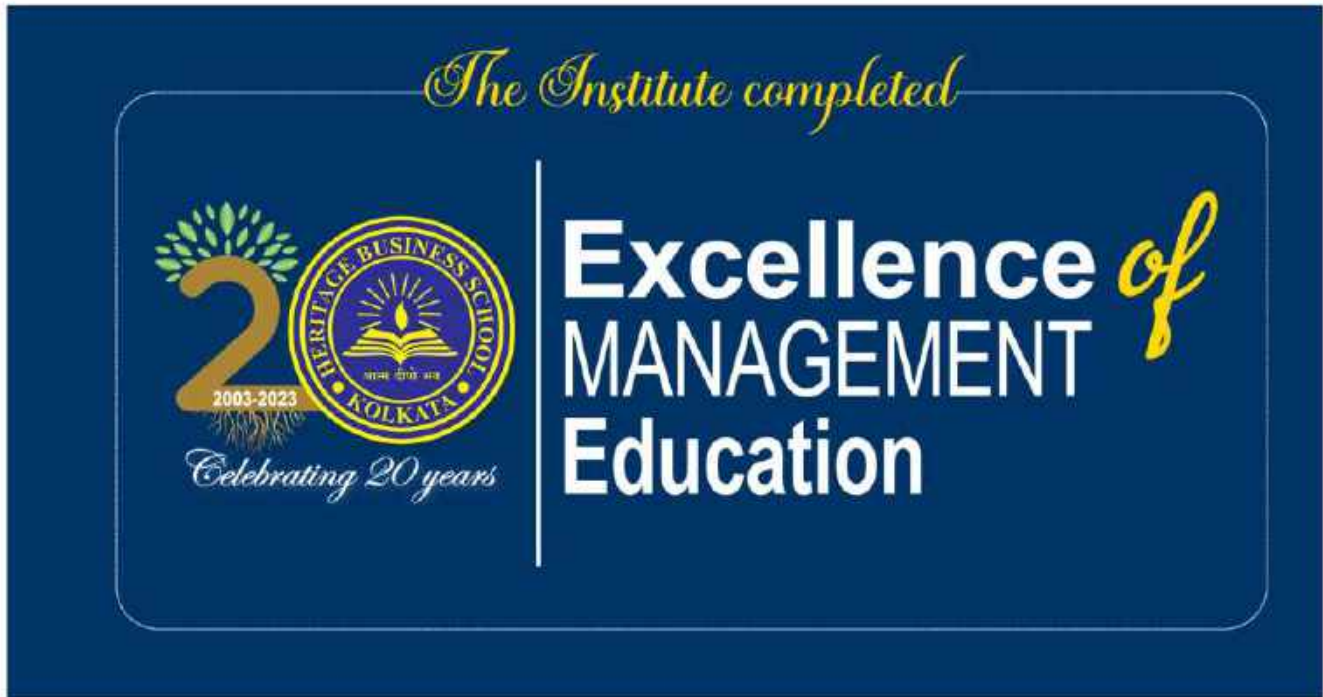

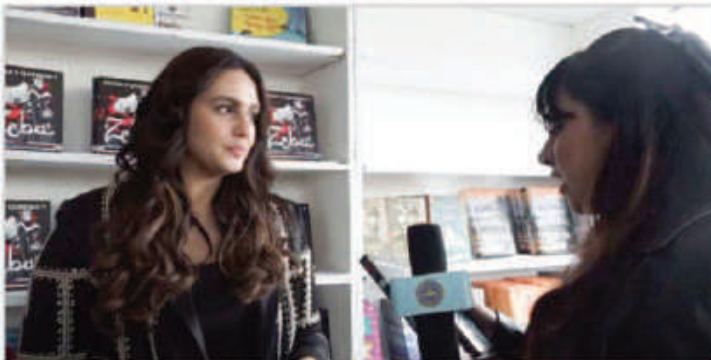

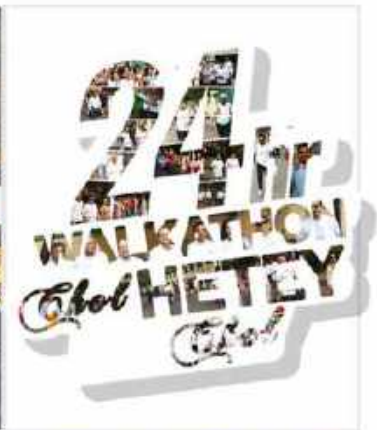
