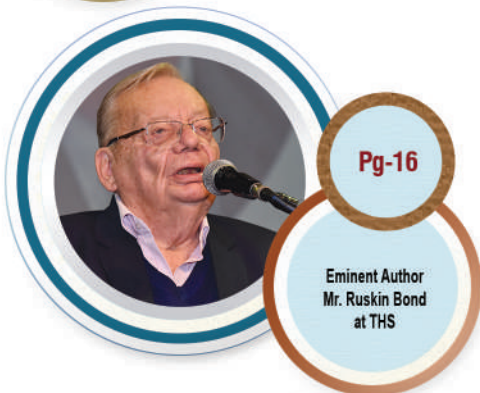

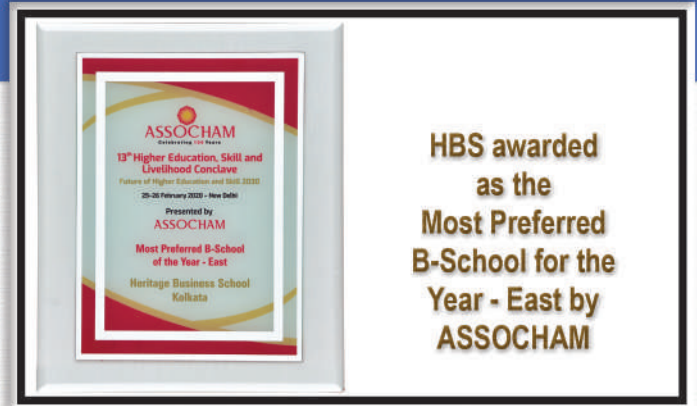

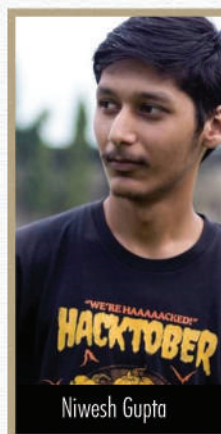

Kolkata Athletic Meet 2020

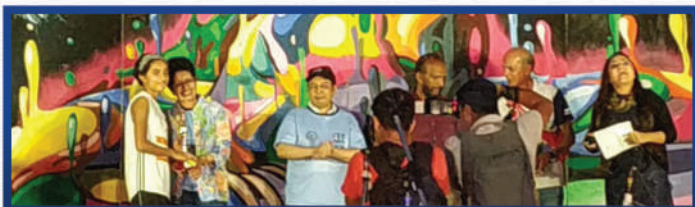

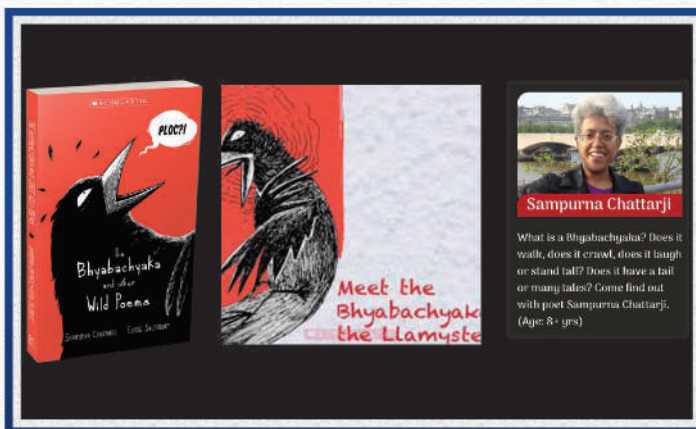


International visits @ The Heritage School

Emergency Medical Training

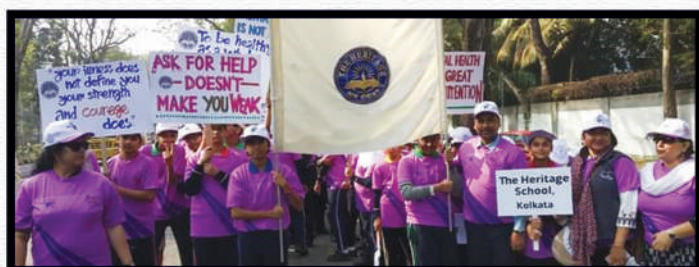
Our students and teachers took part in an Emergency Medical Training conducted by the doctors of Charnok Hospital on 10th January, 2020.

When asked how he writes a book, he replied, keeping his sense of humour intact, it is still with a pen or pencil or else typed in the computer by someone else. 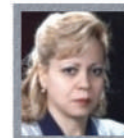

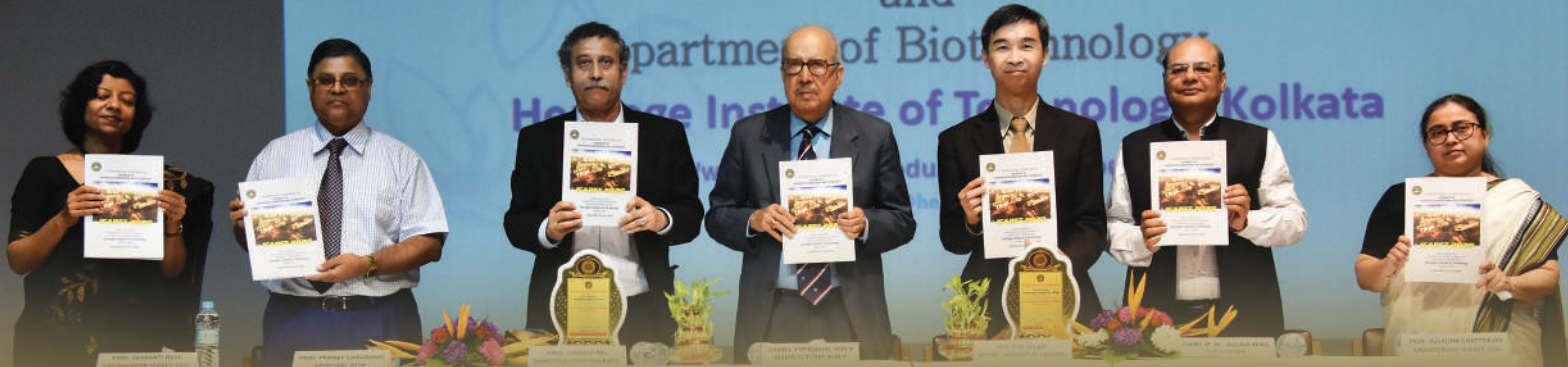

2nd International Conference on Advances in Bioprocess Engineering and Technology-2020

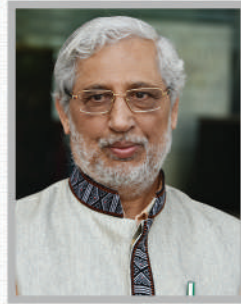
